The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received Plains' report and request for soil closure of the above-referenced site (dated August 2010). The above-referenced report, submitted in partial fulfillment of 19.15.30.19 NMAC (Part 30.19, formally, Rule 19.K), indicates that Plains has partially met the requirements of 19.15.30.9 NMAC for this site. Therefore, the OCD hereby conditionally approves the Soil Closure Request for the TNM 97-18 Release Site and no further soil remediation is required for this site:

The Plains TNM 97-18 Release Site is still active under Abatement Plan, AP-13, and groundwater monitoring, further groundwater contamination delineation if warranted, and groundwater remediation must continue at the Plains TNM 97-18 Release Site.
