The above-referenced report, submitted in partial fulfillment of 19.15.30.19 NMAC (Rule 30.19, formally, Rule 19.K), indicates that Plains has partially met the requirements of 19.15.30.9 NMAC for this site. Therefore, the OCD hereby conditionally approves the Anticipated Actions for the Bob Durham Release Site:

Plains must include groundwater monitoring wells, MW-2, MW-4, MW-7, MW-16, and MW-38 for the analyses of PAHs at the Bob Durham Release Site.

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received Plains' report and request for soil closure of the above-referenced site (dated August 2010). The above-referenced report, submitted in partial fulfillment of 19.15.30.19 NMAC (Part 30.19, formally, Rule 19.K), indicates that Plains has partially met the requirements of 19.15.30.9 NMAC for this site. Therefore, the OCD hereby conditionally approves the Soil Closure Request for the Bob Durham Release Site and no further soil remediation is required for this site:

The Plains Bob Durham Release Site is still active under Abatement Plan, AP-16, and groundwater monitoring, further groundwater contamination delineation if warranted, and groundwater remediation must continue at the Plains Bob Durham Release Site.
