Initially 180bbls of produced water was released from the water tanks at the Folk Federal Tank Battery. We were able to recover 160bbls with vacuum trucks. The water ran onto the location 60' x 60' and traveled down the lease road 20' x 90'; It then went off into the pasture 3' x 150'. The location and lease road were immediately scraped of contaminates and returned to their prior condition. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area in the pasture to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD / BLM for approval prior to any significant remediation work.

Please see the detailed description below of a release that occurred at the Folk Federal TB.

On 3-5-11 at 5:00 a.m., the produced water tank ran over at the Folk Fed Battery. This was caused by an unexpected flush of produced water which outran the transfer pump and the water truck. 180bbls of produced water was released and 160bbls were recovered. The retaining dike allowed the fluid to pass through and the liquid measured an area of 60' X 60' on location, 20' X 90' on lease road, and 3' X 150' in pasture on an existing right of way. Standing fluids were removed and disposed. Contaminated soil within dike, on the location, and on the lease road will be removed and disposed.
