The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received the Corrective Action Plan for the BD B-29 Site, dated April 13, 2011 (and addendum, dated May 9, 2011) and has conducted a review of the Plan. The Plan indicates that Rice Operating Company (ROC) has met the requirements of 19.15.29 NMAC (Part 29; formerly, Rule 116) for a remediation plan. Therefore, the OCD hereby conditionally approves the Corrective Action Plan as proposed for above-referenced site in accordance with 19.15.29 NMAC:
