Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 26, 1956 for immediate approval for an exception to Rule 309 (a) in the Hardy Pool.

It is understood that this exception to Rule 309 (a) is to be ascribed to your State "25" lease known as State Lease No. B-11349, which consists of the S/2 SE/4 of Section 25, Township 20 South, Range 37 East and has wells No. 1 and 2 on the same lease and your State 25 "A" Lease known as State Lease No. E-1402, which is the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 25 and has Well No. 1 on same lease, all in the Hardy Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 309 (b)-4 of the Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, you are hereby authorized to operate a central tank battery on the above described acreage as an exception to Rule 309 (a).
