## Gentlemen:

We regret to inform you that we are unable to approve your proposal to amend NMOCC Order CTB-23 to include Lazy "J" Pennsylvanian production from Section 36, T-138, R-33E and from the SELSWig of Section 35, T-138, R-33E.

Under Rule 53 of our regulations, approval may be obtained to commingle production between different state leases provided that the production is from land belonging to one common state beneficiary and provided that the production from each state lease is properly metered.

As we understand from your proposal, as indicated by your schematic diagram, there are no facilities to separately meter the production derived from the two state leases involved, ie. State of New Mexico Leases B-11264 and B-
