As outlined in Rule 309 of the Commission Rules and Regulations, permission is requested to commingle production from the wells on our State of New Mexico "G" leases. These leases are E-8183 located in the SW/4 of Section 28-19S-35E and E-8184 located in the W/2 SE/4, SE/4 SE/4 of Section 28-19S-35E; SW/4 SW/4 of Section 27-19S-35E. These leases are located in the Pearl Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. We propose to have one separator and storage installation to handle the production from the Queen Sand from the above mentioned acreage.

In a letter dated February 24, 1958 the State Land Office granted their permission to commingle production since the acreage in both leases is credited to the penitentiary.
