Gentlemen:

We have applied to the Commissioner of Public Lands, State of New Mexico, to combine State Lease B-10907, which covers among other lands, the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 5, and State Lease B-9171, which covers among other lands, the E/2 SW/4 and SW/4 SW/4 of Section 5, both being located in T-12-S, R-32-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The mineral ownership under the two (2) leases is dedicated to a common beneficiary. The producing formation is from a common source. There is room for only four (4) wells on the above described acreage so that a common tank battery will not be used for more than four (4) wells.



Gentlemen:

Great Western Drilling Company is the owner of the above captioned leases. We now have a producing oil well located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 5, which falls under State Lease B-9171, and a producing oil well located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 5, which falls under State Lease B-10907. The two (2) producing wells are producing from a common formation, known as the Queen Sand Formation.

Under State Lease B-10907, there are two (2) undrilled locations, located in the E/2 SW/4 of Section 5, and it is contemplated that the two (2) undrilled locations will also be productive in the Queen Sand Formation.

There are no overriding royalty owners under the above captioned leases.

It is the desire of Great Western Drilling Company to commingle the oil from the two (2) above mentioned leases into a common tank battery, insofar as said leases cover the SE/4 NW/4, the E/2 SW/4 and the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 5, T-13-8, R-32-E. We hereby request that you grant us permission to commingle the oil.
