Gentlemen:

By the authority of Robert Travis Canon, operator for Carthay Land Company, we have been designated as agents to make application for an exception to Rule 309 (a) for a central tank battery on two state leases, more fully described as state lease number B-7849, 80 acres, being the 3/2 of SW/4 and state lease number B-1830, 80 acres, being the N/2 of Sw/L of Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.


Carthy Land Company drilled and completed two wells on the above described acreage in 1959. Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 of the SU/4 of Section 16 was completed in March 1959. Well No. 2, located in the NE/4 of SU/4 of said Section 16, was completed in August 1959.

Since both these wells were on state land and the acreage was committed to a common fund, the State Land Office granted Carthay Land Company permission to produce both wells into one tank battery by a letter to Carthay Land Company dated June 26, 1959. A copy of this letter is enclosed.

Through an oversight the operator failed to obtain an exception to Rule 309 (a) from the Oil Conservation Commission at this time, and has filed all reports as one state lease with two producing wells.

In view of the foregoing circumstances and the following information, we are asking that this letter be accepted as an application for exception to Rule 309 (a):

- 1. Both wells are producing from the same common source of supply.
- 2. The acreage involved is contiguous and the production is dedicated to a common beneficiary.
