Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated April 18, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit Texas Pacific Coal and Oil Company to commingle the Langlie-Mattix production from your Eaton "B" Account 1 Lease and your Eaton "B" Account 2 Lease comprising the NE/4 and the NW/4, respectively, of Section 12, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately and continuously metering the production from each lease.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, Texas Pacific Coal and Oil Company is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for temperature-compensated meters and non-reset counters on the meters.
