Gentlemen:

Authorization is hereby requested to commingle  
the oil produced from the above captioned leases into  
a common tank battery as provided for in Rule No. 509-B

All of the production involved is the same gravity  
and value coming from a common source of supply, the  
Grayburg - San Andres Zone of the Red Lake Pool. The  
oil will be metered in strapped storage tanks and flow  
lines are arranged to provide that production from  
every well can be segregated at monthly or lesser in-  
tervals to accurately test the amount of oil produced  
by each well. All parties owning an interest of any  
kind in these leases have the same interest in all three  
leases. Approval of the Commissioner of Public Lands  
of the State of New Mexico for this commingling has  
been secured. Letters to all parties of interest and  
the purchaser of the oil have been sent by certified  
mail advising them of this request.

The oil involved is produced by a secondary re-  
covery waterflood project authorized by the Commission  
under Order No. R-2461.

Attached to this request are the following exhibits:

1. A plat of the leases showing the well locations, flow lines and tank battery.
2. Photostat of the Commissioner of Public Lands letter of approval.
3. Copies of letters to parties of interest and the purchaser of the commingled oil.

It appears that all the conditions required to obtain an administrative order authorizing the commingling of this oil production are present. It will be appreciated if you see fit to grant the order at your earliest opportunity.

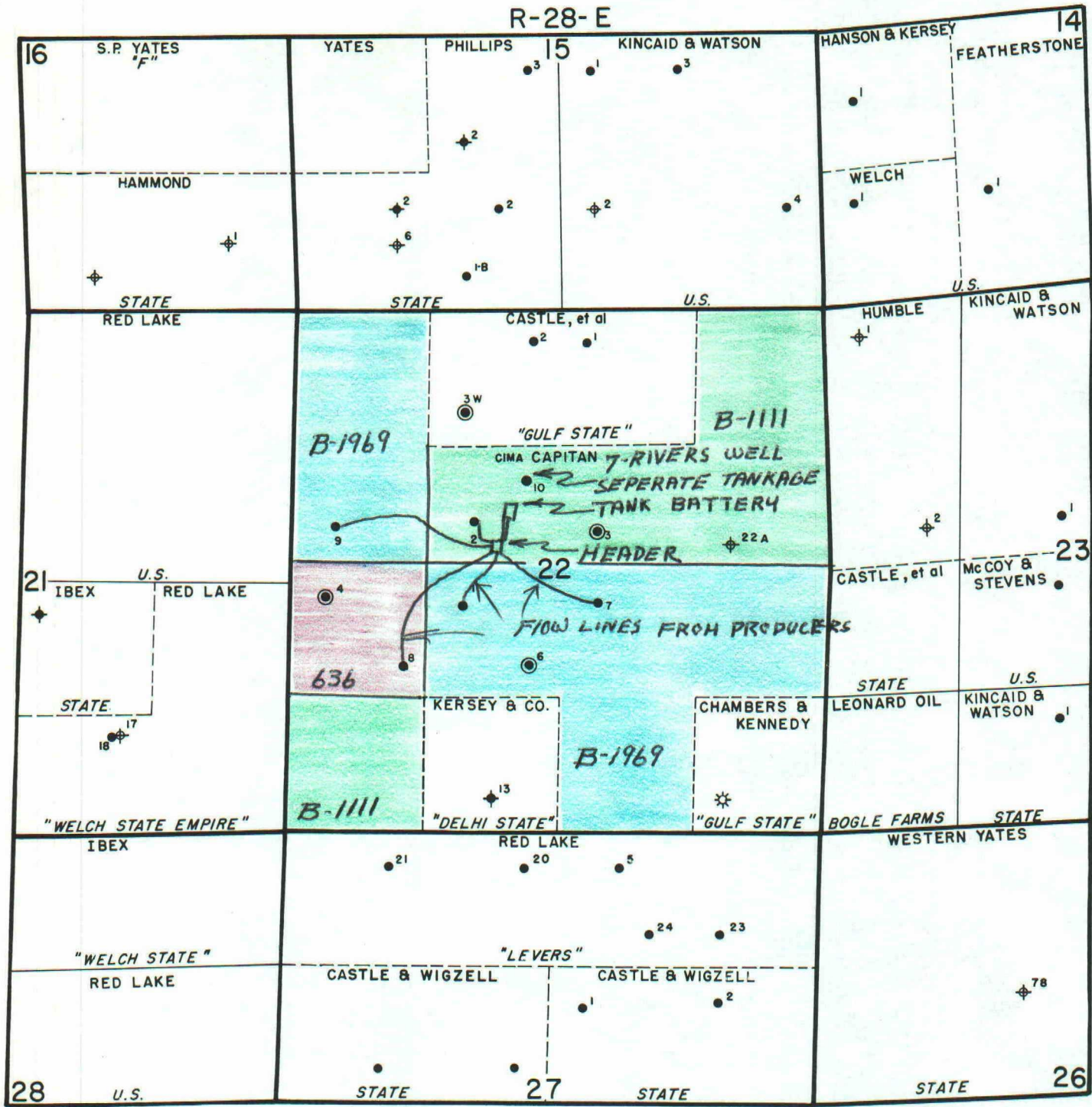



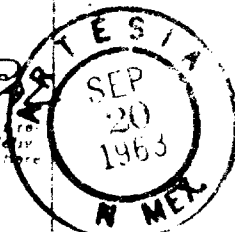
