Dear Mr. Porter:

Reference is made to your Administrative Order CTB-115 granting administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Lusk Strawn Oil Pool production from our Plains Unit Wells. In compliance with this order, upon completion of Plains Unit Wells No. 6 and 7, now drilling, we will meter and sample each well stream separately prior to commingling until such time as they are included in a participating area. The Strawn participating area has been enlarged to include Wells No. 2 and 3X, and we are now producing these two wells into a common separator prior to metering and sampling.

This information is being furnished for your record of metering installations under CTB-115.
