Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated February 20, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Vacuum-Abo production from your State 4-27 Lease and your State 6-34 Lease comprising the N/2 SW/4 and W/2 SE/4 of Section 27, and the S/2 of Section 34, respectively, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production to each lease on the basis of periodic well tests.

It is our understanding that the working interest ownership and the royalty ownership underlying all of the above-described acreage is common throughout, and that the Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico has approved the proposed commingling.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309 (b), Standard Oil Company of Texas is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
