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Pan American Petroleum Corporation hereby respectfully requests and submits application for administrative approval for the commingling of production from separate leases as follows:

State "DA" Well No. 1, Unit E, Section 35, T-7-S, R-33-E, NMPM, Roosevelt County, New Mexico

State "DE" Well No. 1, Unit N, Section 35, T-7-S, R-33-E, NMPM, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

In support of our request for exception to Rule 309-A, and under the provisions of Rule 309-B to permit the commingling of production from two separate leases into a common tank battery without notice and hearing, the following is submitted:

- 1. Plats of the leases, showing thereon the wells and the formation in which they are completed.
- 2. Schematic diagram of the commingling facility, located in Unit E, Section 35, T-7-S, R-33-E, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.
- 3. Production is from a common source of supply, and the commercial value of the commingled production will be unchanged.
- 4. All parties owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the commingled production have been notified by certified mail of our intention to commingle the production from these leases.

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- 5. The production will be separately measured, utilizing A. O. Smith T-6 temperature compensated meters equipped with samplers. A BS&W reading will be taken each eight days and production recorded.
- 6. Production from the separate leases is diversified, and each lease shall be accurately measured and determined in accordance with the "Manual For Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

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
