Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated July 25, 1966, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Chaveroo-San Andres production on your State "DB" Lease comprising the W/2 and SW/4 SE/4 of Section 25, and your State "DF" Lease comprising the ME/4 SE/4 of Section 25, all in Township 7 South, Range 33 East, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.
