Re: Application of Continental Oil Company for Administrative Approval as Provided by Rule 309-B to Commingle Queen Oil Production from Its Pearsall "A" and Pearsall "AX" Leases Located In Section 33, T-17S, R-32E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company requests administrative approval as provided by Rule 309-B, to commingle Queen oil production from its Pearsall "A" and Pearsall "AX" leases located in Section 33, T-17S, R-32E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof submits the following data.

- The Pearsall "A" and Pearsall "AX" leases produce from a common reservoir - the Pearsall-Queen Pool.
- 2. The Pearsall "A" lease consists of the N/2 and SE/4 of Section 33, and the Pearsall "AX" lease consists of the SW/4 of Section 33, both in T-17S, R-32E, Lea County, New Mexico. A plat, Exhibit No. 1, attached hereto, shows the leases, the wells thereon, the battery sites and the location of the proposed commingling facility.
- 3. Mineral rights under both leases are held by the Federal Government; however, the Pearsall "AX" lease carries a different royalty rate than the Pearsall "A" lease

- 4. Queen oil production from each lease will be segregated until after being treated, metered and sampled. For sales, it is proposed to utilize the ACT unit at the Pearsall "AX" tank battery. This ACT unit was authorized by NMOCC ACT Permit I-279 dated December 14, 1967.
- 5. One test facility (separator, meter and sampler) will be used for testing all wells on both leases. A schematic diagram, Exhibit No. 2, attached hereto, shows the proposed installation. As gas volumes from both leases are insufficient for sales and are utilized only for fuel and field operations, no gas return lines are indicated. With this exception, the facility conforms to the requirements of the "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities" dated September 13, 1961.
- 6. Commingling of production will result in the prevention of waste and will not impair correlative rights.

In view of the facts stated above, it is respectfully requested that Administrative approval be granted under Rule 309-B for the commingling of Queen oil production from the applicant's Pearsall "A" and Pearsall "AX" leases as described above. CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY




Dear Mr. Morris:

Attached for your consideration are copies of letters addressed to the NNOCC and the USCS wherein Continental requests approval to commingle oil production. Also attached is a plat showing the location of the proposed commingling facility and a diagram of the proposed producing and metering facility.

As an overriding royalty owner under the Fearsall "AX" lease, your approval of the proposed commingling of oil is herewith requested. The production from both the Fearsall "A" and the Fearsall "AX" leases would be metered separately prior to storage in a common tank battery. The separate metering will allow payment to be made on an individual lease production basis just as would be possible with separate batteries. Our proposal to commingle the oil produced is prompted by the opportunity to eliminate investment and operating cost of maintaining two separate tank batteries and/or ACT facilities. Mr. J. H.
