Administrative Order CTB-185

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated May 27, 1969, for an amendment to Administrative Order CTB-185 which, as amended, authorizes the commingling of production from certain lands in Sections 7 and 8, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that you now wish to add to the commingling authority the S/2 of the NW/4 of Section 9, Township 17 South, Range 33 East.

Inasmuch as the proposed method of allocation in the original order was agreeable to all interested parties and the equities will not be disturbed by the inclusion of the S/2 of the NW/4 of Section 9, Administrative Order CTB-185 is hereby amended as described above.
