Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated May 1, 1969, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Baum-Upper Pennsylvanian production from your State "T" lease comprising the SE/4 of Section 32, Township 13 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and the NW/4 of Section 4, Township 14 South, Range 33 East, and your State "U" lease comprising the E/2 of said Section 4, after separately metering the production from each lease.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, Cabot Corporation is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters and temperature-compensated meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as this installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made thereof.
