NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." FURTHER: The operator shall notify the district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.

NOTE: Two of the wells, Nos.3 and 4 were previously authorized for commingling of production under Division Order OLS-175. For all intents and purpose, commingling of the subject wells is accomplished by the issuance of the subject order. Division Order OLS-175 is hereby placed in abeyance.
