The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle Grayburg Jackson Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool (28500) production from the following leases:

Lease: McIntyre 'A' Well No.1 (State Lease No.LC-054280)
Description: NE/4 SE/4, and;

Lease: McIntyre 'A' Well Nos.3 and 9 (State Lease No.LC-057634)
Description: NW/4 SE/4,

all in Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.


Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each well prior to commingling.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored in the McIntyre 'A' tank battery facility located in Unit Letter 'J' of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.
