

COMMINGLING ORDER CTB-452 2nd Amendment

The above named company is hereby authorized to commingle Monument-Abo Pool (46970) production from the following leases:

Lease:	State A '26' Well Nos.5 and 6
Description:	W/2 SW/4, Section 26, and,
Lease:	Weir 'B' State Well No.2
Description:	NW/4 SE/4, Section 26, and,
Lease:	Monument '23' State Well No.19
Description:	SW/4 SW/4, Section 23

all located Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production from the Monument "23" State Well No. 19 shall be metered prior to commingling. Remaining production shall be allocated to each lease by well tests as long as all commingled production is of identical ownership including working interest, royalty interest, and overriding royalty interest.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored in the State 'A' No.5 tank battery facility located in Unit Letter 'L' of Section 26, Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs district office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling process.
