The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Warren-McKee (Oil - 63270), Warren-Tubb (Oil - 63280), Blinebry Oil & Gas (Oil - 6660) and **East Skaggs-Abo (Oil - 56630)** Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Southeast Monument Unit McKee
Description: Sections 18, 19, 20, 29 & 30, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM,

Lease: Southeast Monument Unit Blinebry
Description: Sections 18, 19, 20, 29 & 30, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM,

Lease: Southeast Monument Unit Tubb A Lease
Description: Sections 18, 19, 20, 29 & 30, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM,

Lease: Burger "B-20" Lease
Description: SE/4 NW/4 of Section 20, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM,

All in Lea County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling.


NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored at the SEMU "BMT" battery located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 20, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.

Dear Mark,

The Oil Conservation Division has previously approved the commingling of McKee, Blinebry, and Tubb production from Sections 18, 19, 20, 29 and 30, T20S, R38E at Conoco's SEMU "BMT" battery. Please see attached a copy of the latest "Amended", Commingling Order PLC-67 pertaining to this production facility.

The Burger B-20, Well #4 is currently approved under the above referenced order to produce Warren McKee pool "sweet" production into the battery. The oil is metered separately and then commingled in the run tank. The gas is metered and sold to GPM via a total flow gas meter. Conoco intends to recomplete Well #4 in the East Skaggs Abo pool. The Abo crude oil production gravity is sweet and has a gravity of 45 API degrees. The "BMT" battery oil gravity is 41.6 API degrees. We do not believe that the Abo gravity would effect the price per barrel.

Conoco is requesting permission to add production from the East Skaggs Abo to the existing Commingling Order PLC-67. I have enclosed copies of the area map and battery diagram. If you need any further information concerning this request, please contact me as listed below. Thank you.

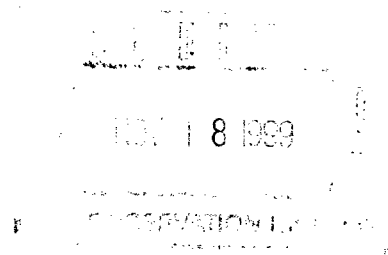

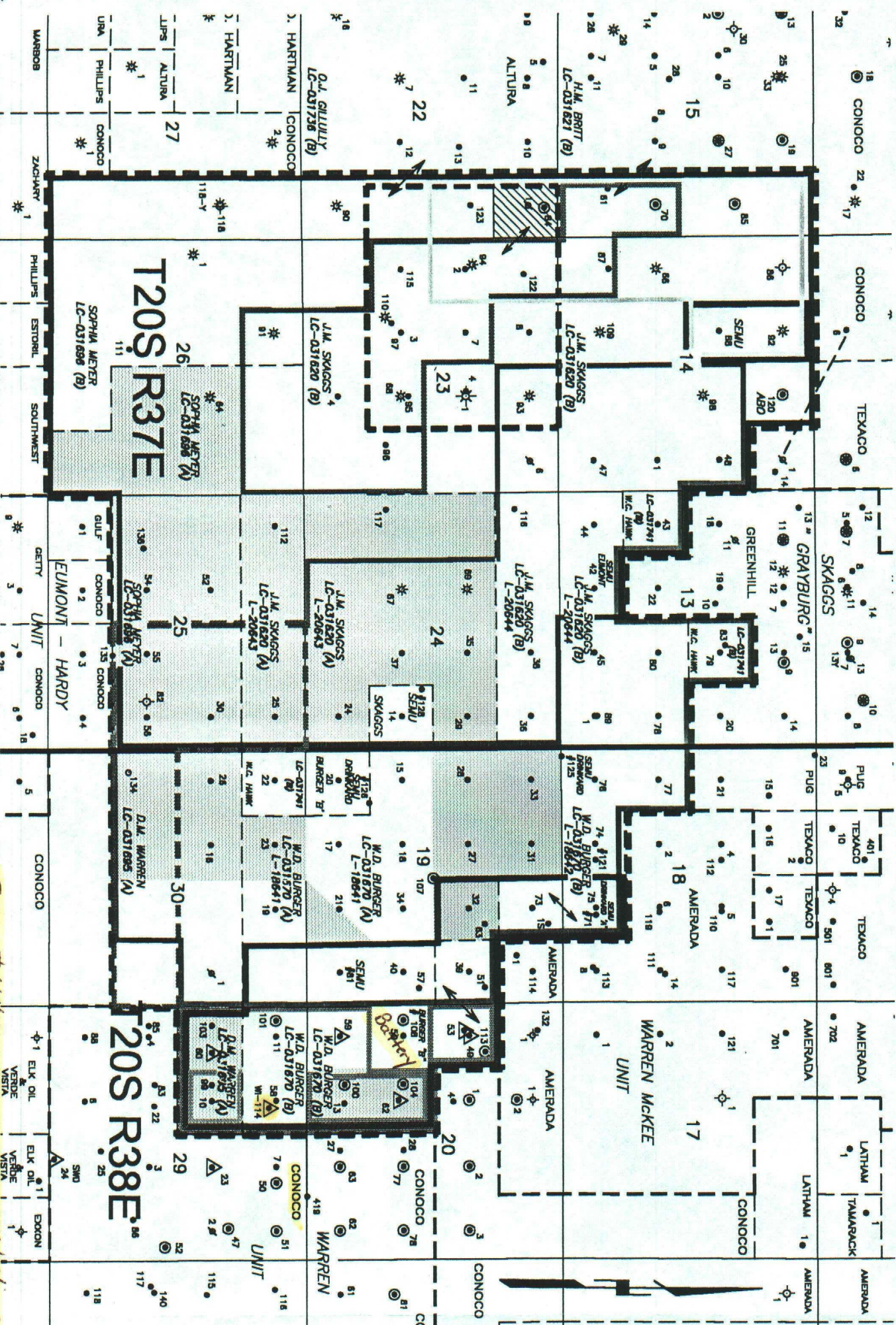
