4th AMENDED COMMINGLING ORDER PLC - 99

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle South Corbin Bone Spring (13160) and South Corbin Wolfcamp (13320) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Federal '21' Well No.4 (LC-064944)
Description: NW/4 NE/4, and,

Lease: Federal 'MA' Well Nos.2 and 8 (NM-96781)
Description: NE/4 SE/4 and SE/4 NE/4, and,

Lease: Aztec '22' Well No.2 (NM-0997)
Description: NW/4 NW/4,

all in Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.

REMARKS: The commingled production from the subject leases shall be stored in the Aztec '22' tank battery facility located in Unit Letter F of the Section 22, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.


NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

NOTE: Validation of this authority shall be accomplished by like approval by the U.S. Bureau of Land Management.

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REMARKS: Any further revision of the commingling authority granted herein shall require the matter being brought before an examiner hearing of the Oil Conservation Division.
