The production from the Darius 'ADS' Federal Lease is sent through a heater treater where it is metered prior to going to the battery which is located 1980' FSL & 2310' FEL, Sec. 30, T23S, R32E, Lea County, New Mexico. A test meter will be set at the Darius 'ADS' Federal # 1 location prior to being commingled with the Little Jack '30' Federal lease at the sales meter.

Meridian is 100% working interest owner for all the wells in the Little Jack '30' Federal Lease. Meridian has 45.85% working interest for the Darius 'ADS' Federal Lease. However, our partners do concur with the commingling process and their interests are protected via the measuring methods.

The proposed commingling of production is in the interest of conservation and will not result in reduced royalty or improper measurement of production. The proposed commingling is necessary to continue operations for the above referenced federal leases.
