COMMINGLING ORDER PLC – 120 1st Amendment

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle South Corbin-Wolfcamp (Oil - 13320) and **South Corbin-Strawn (Oil - 13300)** Pool production from the following leases:

Lease:Querecho Federal Wells No.1 and 2 (NM0997)Description:E/2 SW/4 of Section 28, and;

Lease: Uncle Federal Wells No.1 and 3 (NM0997) Description: NE/4 NW/4 and SW/4 NE/4 of Section 28,

both in Township 18 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by separately metering the production from the Querecho Federal Lease and determining the Uncle Federal Lease production by the subtraction method. Allocation of gas production shall be determined by well tests. (All ownership is common).

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: Commingled production shall be stored in the Uncle Federal No.3 tank battery facility located in Unit G of Section 28, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.
