The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Dollarhide-Queen (Oil - 18810) and Dollarhide-Tubb Drinkard (Oil - 18830) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Elliott "31" Federal Well No. 6 (Federal Lease No. LC-069052)
Description: NW/4 NW/4 of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, NMPM,

Lease: Elliott "31" Federal Well No. 8 (Federal Lease No. NM-0349953)
Description: SW/4 NW/4 of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, NMPM,

All in Lea County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each lease by well tests. (If this method is to be authorized, all commingled production must be of identical ownership including working interest, royalty interest, and overriding royalty interest.)

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.


REMARKS: The commingled production shall be stored at the Elliott "31" Federal battery located in NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.

PROVIDING: Validation of this authority shall be accomplished with like approval from the U.S. Bureau of Land Management.
