ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order R-972-B, The Graridge Corporation, has made application to the Commission on May 25, 1959, for permission to expand its North Caprock Queen Unit No. 1 Water Flood Project in the Caprock-Queen Pool, Lea and Chaves Counties, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 1st day of July, 1959, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1.. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-972B.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order R-972-B.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Graridge Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to-wit:

Unit Well No. 36-8 located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 36 and Unit Well No. 36-10 located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 36, both in Township 12 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 1390 feet in the aforesaid Well No. 36-8 and shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 1540 feet in the aforesaid Well No. 36-10.
