Gentlemen:

Reference is made to Administrative Order WFX-12 issued by the Commission on July 13, 1959, and as amended by our letter of July 20, 1959.

This order authorized the conversion for water injection of your North Caprock Queen Unit No. 1 Well No. 7-14 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 7, Township 13 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico, subject to the condition that injection in said well would be through tubing and packer and that said packer would be set at 625 feet or deeper.

After consideration of the statements in your letter of July 24, 1959, to the State Engineer of New Mexico, the State Engineer has advised the Oil Conservation Commission that he has no objection to the completion of the subject well without the above described tubing and packer.

Administrative Order WFX-12 is hereby amended to delete that portion which requires that injection should be through tubing and packer.
