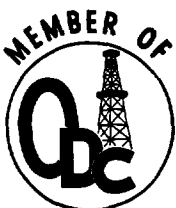

Well No. 13-3 in Tract 8, NE/4 of NW/4 of Section 13, T-13-S, R-31-E, North Central Caprock Queen Unit, has received response since July 28 (C-116 attached). The stimulated well No. 13-3 is directly offset by the proposed Injection Well No. 13-6. Therefore, as provided in Order No. R-1311, Great Western Drilling Company applies for the expansion of the North Central Caprock Queen Unit by reason of the conversion of Unit Well No. 13-6.

We respectfully submit that the ultimate recoverable oil from the Caprock Queen reservoir will be decreased and waste will occur due to an unbalanced condition in the pattern flooding system if Unit Well No. 13-6 is not converted to a Water Injection Well at this time.

There are attached copies of the C-116 of Great Western Drilling Company's Well No. 13-3 showing stimulation, and a plat of the area showing all producing wells, water injection wells, and proposed water injection well; and, further showing all offset Operators.

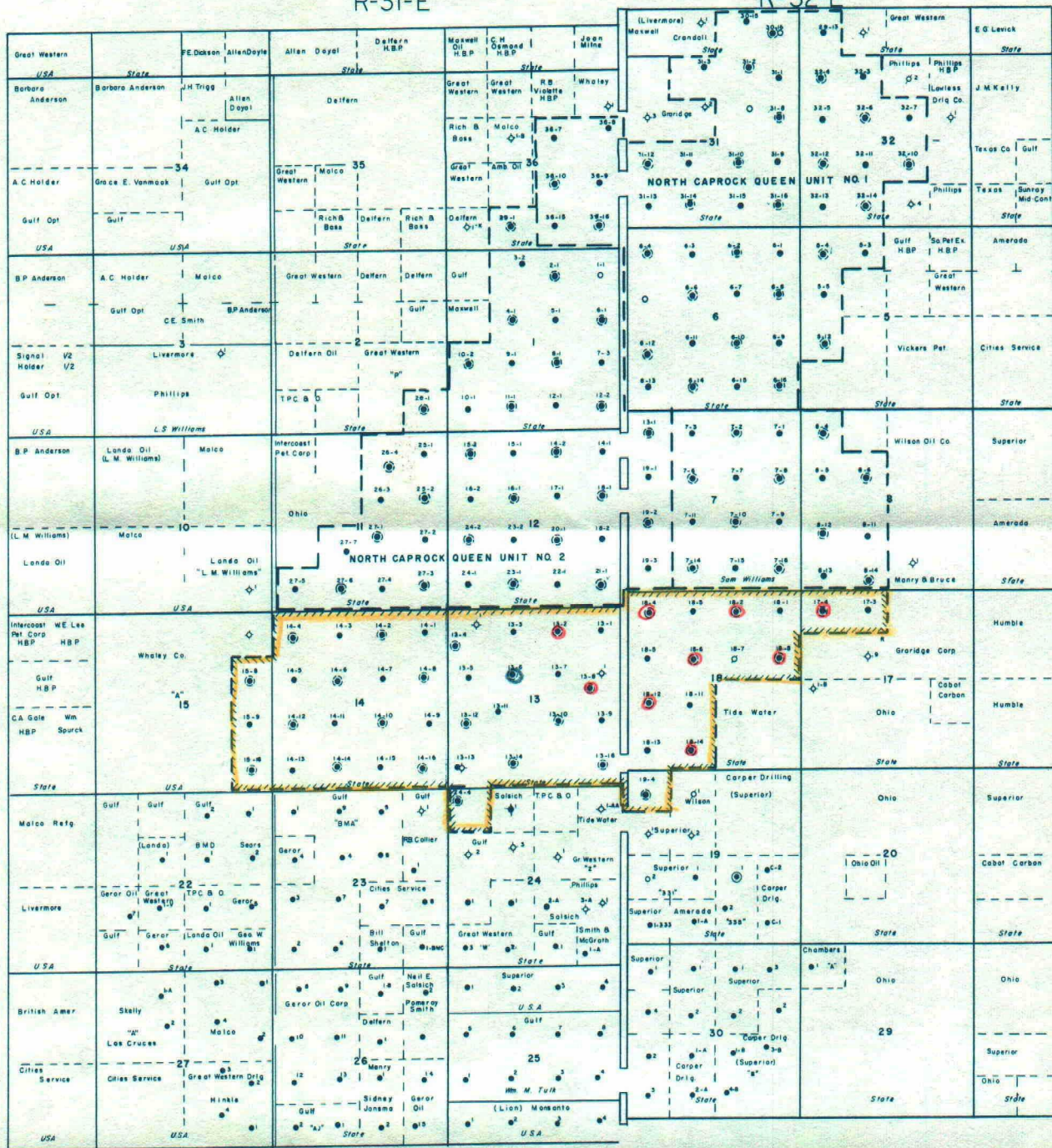

No well will be assigned an allowable greater than the amount of oil produced on the official test.

During gas-oil ratio test, each well shall be produced at a rate not exceeding the top unit allowable for the pool in which well is located by more than 25 percent. Operator is encouraged to take advantage of this 25 percent tolerance in order that well can be assigned increased allowables when authorized by the Commission.

Gas volumes must be reported in MCF measured at a pressure base of 15.025 psia and a temperature of 60 degrees F. Specific gravity base will be 0.60.

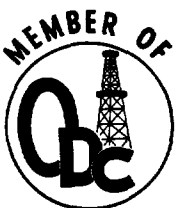

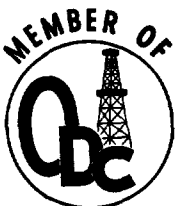
