APPLICATION OF NEWMONT OIL COMPANY TO EXPAND ITS WATER FLOOD PROJECT IN THE SQUARE LAKE POOL IN EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO. Administrative Order WFX NO. 94

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION CONMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2064, Newmont Oil Company has made application to the Commission on November 1, 1961, for permission to expand its Water Flood Project in the Square Lake Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico,

NOW, on this 16th day of November, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed in Order No. R-2064.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2064.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED!

That the applicant, Newmont Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

State "C" Well No. 2 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 32 State "C" Well No. 4 located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 32 Johnson Well No. 1 located in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 33 Johnson Well No. 2 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 28 Texas Trading Federal Well No. 2 located in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 33, all in Township 16 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.

Done at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
