ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2269, General American Oil Company of Texas has made application to the Commission on June 27, 1962, for permission to convert its Nunlee Well No. 5 in the Square Lake Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico,

NOW, on this 27th day of July, 1962, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2269.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2269.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, General American Oil Company of Texas, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Nunlee Well No. 5 located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section
35, Township 16 South, Range 29 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER: That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set well below the top of the cement outside the production casing.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
