ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Water Flood Associates, Inc., has made application to the Commission on March 18, 1964, for permission to expand its Robinson Water Flood Project in the Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 2nd day of April, 1964, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Water Flood Associates, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Well No. 5 State located in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 2, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 3490' in liner of said well.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
