ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Cities Service Oil Company has made application to the Commission on June 8, 1964, for permission to expand its Drickey Queen Sand Unit Water Flood Project in the Caprock-Queen Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico,

NOW, on this 23rd day of June, 1964, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notifed of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Cities Service Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Tract 2 Well No. 1 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 15, Township 14 South, Range 31 East, NMPM,

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set approximately 2875 feet in the production casing in said well.
