ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2916, Worldwide Petroleum Corporation has made application to the Commission on September 16, 1965, for permission to expand its Seven Lakes Water Flood Project in the Seven Lakes Oil Pool, McKinley County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 1st day of October, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2916.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2916.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Worldwide Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Menefee formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Santa Fe Well No. 13-W located 35 feet FNL and 1980 feet FEL of Section 19, Santa Fe Well No. 11-W located 32 feet FNL and 2635 feet FEL of Section 19, Santa Fe Well No. 12-W located 665 feet FNL and 2635 feet FEL of Section 19, and Farris Well No. 8-W located 660 feet FSL and 2635 feet FEL of Section 18, all in Township 18 North, Range 10 West, NMPM.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
