## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Gulf Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on March 30, 1966, for permission to expand its West Pearl Queen Unit Water Flood Project in the Pearl-Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 14th day of April, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
  - 6. That the application should be approved.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following-described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 158 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 32, Township 19 South, Range 35 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 4675 feet in the production casing of said well.
