ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Archie M. Speir has made application to the Commission on December 22, 1966, for permission to expand its South Red Lake Grayburg Unit Water Flood Project in the Red Lake Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 6th of January, 1967, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Archie M. Speir, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Premier Sand-Grayburg formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Tract 10 Well No. 1 located 2310' FSL and 1650' FWL of
Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 27 East, NMPM

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete said well in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's letter dated April 5, 1965, pertaining to completion of previously authorized injection wells.
