I have an overriding royalty covering the shallow rights being water flooded in Section 14, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. I am also owner of the deep rights to this section of land.

Atlantic's water flood pattern is as shown on the attached plat. They have recently drilled a well to the south in NE/4 NW/4, Section 23, Township 18 South, Range 31 East.

Atlantic now proposes to drill an injection well in SE/4 SW/4, Section 14.

It appears that this injection well location would not protect the correlative rights of all parties since there would be two injection wells along the south row of wells in Section 14 with no compensating injection in Section 23. Therefore, please accept this letter as my objection to the granting of administrative approval for an injection well location as proposed by Atlantic. In the event that a hearing is set for this matter, I request that you notify me and my New Mexico attorney, Mr. A. J. Losee of Artesia, of the time and place of such hearing.
