## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Newmont Oil Company has made application to the Commission on November 18, 1968, for permission to expand its East Square Lake Water Flood Project in the Square Lake Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 3rd day of December, 1968, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.

2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.

3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.

4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.

5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Newmont Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Texas Trading Well No. 8 located in Unit B of Section 33, Township 16 South, Range 31 East, NMPM

**PROVIDED HOWEVER**, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 2978 feet in the production casing in said well.
