ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3257, Windfohr Oil Company has made application to the Commission on January 29, 1969, for permission to expand its Grayburg Jackson San Andres Unit Waterflood Project in the Grayburg Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 13th day of February, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3257.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3257.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Windfohr Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the San Andres formation through the following-described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 1 located in Unit H of Section 24,
Unit Well No. 4 located in Unit B of Section 24,
Unit Well No. 8 located in Unit B of Section 23,
Unit Well No. 9 located in Unit N of Section 14,
Unit Well No. 15 located in Unit P of Section 13,
Unit Well No. 21 located in Unit J of Section 14,
Unit Well No. 22 located in Unit L of Section 14,
Unit Well No. 23 located in Unit G of Section 14,
Unit Well No. 28 located in Unit H of Section 13,
Unit Well No. 29 located in Unit B of Section 13,
Unit Well No. 33 located in Unit N of Section 12,
Unit Well No. 35 located in Unit P of Section 12,
Unit Well No. 37 located in Unit J of Section 12,

all in Township 17 South, Range 30 East, NMPM,
Lea County, New Mexico.

Further, that the wells to be drilled at the following locations

are to be completed as injection wells in the San Andres formation:

SE/4 NW/4 Section 24; NE/4 NE/4 Section 23;
SE/4 NE/4 Section 12; all in Township 17 South,
Range 30 East, NMPM.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the wells to be converted to water injection wells will be done so in the manner outlined by the application dated January 27, 1969.
