## ADMINISTRATIVE $\Theta$ RDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Leonard Latch has made application to the Commission on March 31, 1969, for permission to expand its Latch Empire Water Flood Project No. 1 in the Empire Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 15th day of April, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
  - 6. That the application should be approved.

That the applicant, Leonard Latch, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Seven Rivers formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:
