ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3704, Amerada Petroleum Corporation has made application to the Commission on April 28, 1969, for permission to expand its Langlie Mattix Woolworth Unit Water Flood Project in the Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 13th day of May, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3704.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3704.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Amerada Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 105 located in Unit F of Section 28,  
Unit Well No. 121 located in Unit H of Section 34, and  
Unit Well No. 707 located in Unit P of Section 27, all in  
Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set just above the injection interval in the above described wells.

Done at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
