ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3756, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on December 22, 1969, for permission to expand its Forest Heard Water Flood Project in the Forest Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 6th day of January, 1970, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3756.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3756.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Nunlee Well No. 3 located in Unit J of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 29 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 2500 feet in said well.
