ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3444A, Tenneco Oil Company has made application to the Commission on July 16, 1970, for permission to expand its Mesa Queen Unit Water Flood Project in the Mesa-Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 31st day of July, 1970, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3444-A.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3444-A.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Tenneco Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 25 located in Unit N of Section 16, Township 16 South, Range 32 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 3383 feet in said well.
