ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3881, Kincaid & Watson Drilling Company has made application to the Commission on September 23, 1970, for permission to expand its East Red Lake Unit Water Flood Project in the East Red Lake Queen-Grayburg Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 8th day of October, 1970, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3881.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3881.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Kincaid & Watson Drilling Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen-Grayburg formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Kincaid State Well No. 1 located in Unit P of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 28 East, NMPM,
Resler & Sheldon Well No. 3 located in Unit B of Section 2, and Atlantic State Well No. 2 located in Unit F of Section 1, both in Township 17 South, Range 28 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set as near to the perforations as is practical.
