Administrative Order WFX No. 364

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3901, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on February 7, 1972 for permission to expand its East E-K Unit Water Flood Project in the East E-K Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 18th day of February, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3901.
- That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3901.
- That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

East E-K Unit Well No. 9, located in Unit E of Sec. 23 and

East E-K Unit Well No. 10, located in Unit L of Sec. 22,

both in Township 18 South, Range 34 East, NMPM.

Provided However, that applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 4409 feet in Well No. 9, and at approximately 4505 feet in Well No. 10.
