ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2403, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on May 3, 1972, for permission to expand its MCA Unit Water Flood Project in the Maljamar Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 8th day of May, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

> 1. That application has been filed in due form.

That inasmuch as the applicant is the only offset 2. operator to the proposed injection well, the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2403 may be dispensed with in this instance.

3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Crder No. R-2403.

That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced 4. water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

> That the application should be approved. 5.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

> MCA Unit Well No. 67 located in Unit L of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 3600 feet in said well.
