APPLICATION OF CITIES SERVICE OIL COMPANY TO EXPAND ITS SOUTHEAST MALJAMAR GRAYBURG SAN ANDRES UNIT WATER FLOOD PROJECT IN THE MALJAMAR POOL IN LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

ORDER WFX NO. 380

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3134-A, Cities Service Oil Company has made application to the Commission on September 26, 1972, for permission to expand its Southeast Maljamar Grayburg San Andres Unit Water Flood Project in the Maljamar Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 11th day of October, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3134-A.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3134-A.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Cities Service Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Tract 1 Well No. 2 located in Unit I of Section 30, Tract 9 Well No. 4 located in Unit A of Section 32, Tract 10 Well No. 4 located in Unit C of Section 32, and Tract 7 Well No. 4 located in Unit I of Section 29, all in Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM,

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set as close to the casing shoe as is practicable.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
