ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3901, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on December 18, 1972, for permission to expand its East E-K Unit Water Flood Project in the East EK-Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 3rd day of January, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3901.
- 4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3901.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Well No. 5 located in Unit O of Section 22, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 4520 feet in said well.
