ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2909, Gulf Oil Company has made application to the Commission on January 24, 1974, for permission to expand its Central Drinkard Unit Water Flood Project in the Drinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 5th day of January, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That waivers of objection have been received from offset operators as prescribed by Order No. R-2909.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. 2909.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Gulf Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Drinkard formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Central Drinkard Unit Well No 160, located in
Unit E, Section 29, Township 21 South, Range
37 East, NMPM.
