ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4068, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on February 14, 1974, for permission to expand its South Eunice Unit Water Flood Project in the South Eunice Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 1st day of March, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-4068.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Seven Rivers-Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

South Eunice Unit Well No. 62, located in Unit O, and South Eunice Unit Well No. 64, located in Unit A, both in Section 33, and South Eunice Unit Well No. 65 located in Unit O of Section 28, all in Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM.
